Annual Water Primacy Fee

The Missouri Department of Natural Resource Public Drinking Water Branch require cities to charge an annual primacy fee to it's water customers. Ash Grove Water system has less than 1000 connections so the Primacy Fee rate set by the state is \$3.24 for residential addresses billed and \$7.44 for large meters. The state uses these fees for testing drinking water, inspections, compliance activites, complaint investigations as well as technical assistance.
