UTILITY BILLING AND OTHER CITY SERVICES

- City Hall now has a new e-mail for all utility billing questions or concerns, business licenses, permits, and rentals. Please e-mail CityServices@ashgrovememo.gov

WINTER WEATHER

We have felt the effects of the winter weather moving in and freezing pipes can be a costly problem for homeowners. Take measures to protect your pipes from freezing such as:

- Opening kitchen and bathroom cabinet doors to allow warm air to circulate.
- Let the water drip in your faucets with pipes running on exterior walls that have little to no insulation.
- Add insulation to attics, basements and crawl spaces.
- Disconnect all outside hoses.
- Repair and seal cracks around windows and doors that can allow cold air to reach indoors.

Please call City Hall at 417-751-2333 ext. 1 during normal business hours or call 911 for after hours water emergencies. They will get you in touch with our public works department. Please do not attempt to turn OFF your water yourself, you will be in violation of Ordinance 700.270. In the event of snow, please park do not park your vehicles in the street. This will give Public Works the ability to safely remove the snow from city streets.
