CITY BUSINESS LICENSES DUE BY JULY 1, 2025

FIREWORKS - CITY ORDINANCE SECTION 210:2290

It shall be unlawful for any person owning or possessing any fireworks to explode, detonate, discharge, or combust fireworks within the city limits, which shall specifically include city parks, schools, streets, or public property, except that fireworks may be used by individuals on their own residential property. The time line to discharge fireworks shall be from June 28th to July 7th. No fireworks shall be exploded or discharged after the hours of 10:00 pm except on the 4th of July until midnight.
